The 2008 Reserva Especial is equal parts Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon with 15% each Tempranillo and Garnacha. It shows more spices and shy notes of developed bouquet, but still feels quite young and unevolved, harmonious and balanced, with well-integrated oak and enough fruit, acidity and tannins. Drink 2014-2018. A textbook blend.
